EVENING & WEEKEND PROGRAMME DETAILS

The Master course lasts 3 months from March 6th 2025 to June 12th 2025.

It is an intensive online programme whose didactic method is based on a hands-on approach, aiming at transferring knowledge through a learning-bydoing process.

All lectures are held in English.

SECTION I: The European institutional system and thematic focus on EU policies and funding programs

Organized by professors of the prestigious Université Catholique de Louvain (UCL), this module provides students with a broad understanding of the European construction, from the historical, legal and economic point of view.

SECTION II: Successful EU projects and tenders: design and management tools and techniques

It focuses on the mechanisms, tools and criteria for designing and managing successful EU-funded projects and tenders. Thanks to interactive team works, students acquire very practical skills.

SECTION III: Job link and meetings with European Experts

This section prepares students for the EU job market through meetings with headhunters and consultations with EU project experts. Students also refine their CVs and cover letters preparing for two interviews with potential employers, to get direct access to career opportunities.



THE JOB-LINK MODULE

The Master course also includes a **job-link module** designed to assist participants in their search for a traineeship or employment position. It provides advice on submitting effective applications and crafting a successful CV.

During this module, students receive **personalized suggestions tailored to their profiles**, along with useful contact lists. Participants are introduced to effective job search techniques and have the opportunity to have their profiles included in a CV book, which is distributed to hundreds of contacts in Brussels and beyond.



APPLICATION

Candidates are required to submit a formal application in English consisting of:

- / The application form
- Copy of the university diploma or equivalent degree (last-year university students shall submit a transcript of records)
- / CV (Europass)
- / Cover letter
- / Language certificate or a language knowledge self-statement
- / One passport-size photograph
- / Copy of passport/ID

SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships of 1.000 € can be granted to admitted candidates, on the basis of both merit and income.
